ELA/Writing:

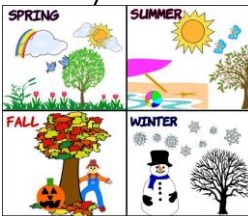
We will continue working with proverbs and adages. We will also learn about antonyms and synonyms.
