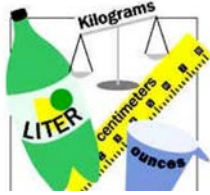
### Reading and ELA/Writing:

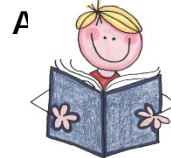

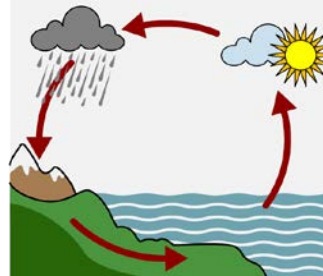
